| English Linked Courses | Students are selected for these courses based on test scores, grades, and teacher recommendations. These are required classes. |
| CareerTech Courses | Students may only take Votech 1 and 2 if they have applied and been approved by CareerTech. |

| SENIOR RELEASE OR | Seniors are eligible if they have a 17English ACT and a 19Math ACT OR if they have a 2.5 |
