INKIND FOOD SERVICE MEALS

ISSUE DATE: **5-22-00**

Cafeteria employees, including those persons responsible for preparing food, cooking, serving of food, operating kitchen equipment, cleaning and storing dishes, utensils, kitchen equipment, as well as that person or persons whose job is to manage food service, are not required to pay for meals, as this is inkind. All other school employees shall be required to pay for meals.

Inkind meals are to consist of the same items as those on the menu each day, prepared in the same manner as those served to the students. Special dishes are not to be prepared for any employee, including those working in the Food Service Program.

Relatives and/or friends of food service employees are not permitted to eat in the school cafeteria unless such person(s) is on the school campus because of employment in the Jackson County School District.

Preferential treatment as relates to food service meals of any student or adult in the school cafeteria is prohibited during regular meal service. Any additional foods over and above that of a regular meal shall carry an extra charge.

Alteration in whole or in part of these regulations shall be in direction violation of Board policy.
