The following employees are required to complete annual special needs training:

- Special Education Bus Drivers
- Special Education Bus Aides
- Special Education Teachers
- Special Education Teacher Assistants
- Special Education Director
- Principal
- Assistant Principal
- Transportation Supervisor
- Assistant Superintendent
- Human Resources
- District Superintendent
