



Textbook and Technology

Textbook and technology (may be) issued by the teacher for each subject. The state-owned textbooks are estimated to last five years. The condition of the book or technology issued to a student is checked at the beginning of the school year and again at the close of the session.

In accordance with House Bill 1063, if a textbook or technology device is lost, damaged beyond use, or not returned by a student who drops out of the district, the parent or legal guardian will be required to compensate the district for the list value of the book(s) and device(s) Lost textbook(s) and device(s) must be paid for before another one is issued. Students who do not pay fines will not be issued books or devices for the following year.

I understand and agree that violation of this agreement will render me responsible for the expense of replacing any lost, stolen or damaged textbook or technology issued to my child.
