(Ex: /l/ in the medial position of words would indicate that your child will practice producing /l/ in words such as "balloon" or "jelly").

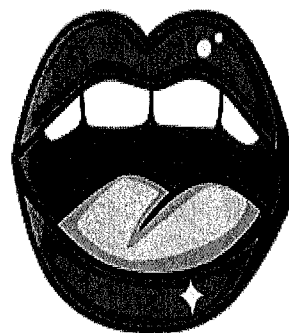

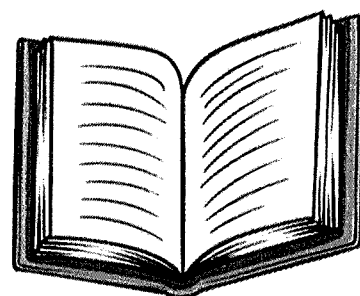

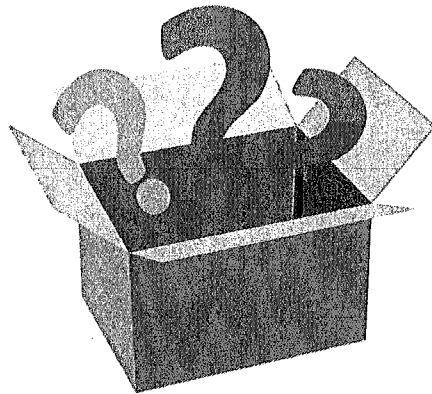
